Re: Change Order 3 Analysis and Justification of Proposed Costs

3873.2 Flood Inundated Areas Street Rehab - Section 2

City of Minot, North Dakota

The contractor submitted unit price of \$25/ton to complete the change order work. This unit price will include all costs the contractor incurs, both direct and indirect associated with material's hauling, placement and compaction in areas designated by the City.

Furthermore, the unit price for this change order is very reasonable when compared to unit prices of alternative materials available at the contract's unit prices such as CL 5 - \$50/ton, CL 13 - \$36.70/ton, CL 29 HBP - \$91/ton.

For the intended purpose of this change order, asphalt millings at \$25/ton is a cost effective and suitable material available to level the north shoulder of 4th Ave NE. Based on the comparable unit prices and the contractor's knowledge of the project, it is recommended that the additional work be authorized via change order to Bechtold Paving as the most time and cost effective option

Re: Change Order 3 Justification and Independent Cost Analysis

3873.2 Flood Inundated Areas Street Rehab - Section 2

City of Minot, North Dakota

The 2" overlay placed on 4th Ave NE resulted in raising finished asphalt grade approx. 1' higher than the existing north shoulder. The City of Minot requested the contractor to place asphalt millings along the north shoulder of 4th Avenue NE to level out the slope.

The quantity required to complete the change order work is estimate to be 150 – 200 tons. Based on contract unit prices for alternate material, such as CL 5 - \$50/ton or CL 13 - \$36.70/ton, the expected cost may range between \$5,505.00 to \$10,000.00.
