## **DRGR ACTION PLAN**

### **SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT #5**

#### **Summary:**

This amendment adds eligible beneficiaries to the Relocation Activity to include tenants affected by voluntary acquisition activity pursuant to the federal Uniform Relocation Act.

#### **Capacity and Soundness of Approach:**

The Grantee does not find that this amendment alters in any way its capacity or soundness of approach in carrying out any of the remaining activities and projects funded under this Action Plan. Adding potential beneficiaries eligible for relocation benefits through voluntary acquisition activity while important to assuring affected tenants are able to access all possible eligible assistance does not significantly impact current availability of funds or delivery of services to existing eligible beneficiaries. It also does not impact the delivery of services to existing eligible beneficiaries. Further, adding a new limited set of new potential beneficiaries does not diminish or adversely affect the primary purpose and focus of the relocation activity which is in support of acquisitions necessary to accomplish flood control and mitigate projects.

#### **Benefit/Cost Analysis:**

This amendment is non-financial and, as such, does not affect existing benefits projected for all existing Action Plan projects and activities. An internal financial analysis by the Grantee has determined that there is sufficient fund availability within the current allocation for the related activities and that adding potential beneficiaries does not affect ability to meet current goals and needs in use of funds.

#### **Location of Change in Action Plan:**

Page 8 of the Consolidated Action Plan, Relocation Services under Activity Description will have the following language added to the existing description: “or as the result of a voluntary acquisition connected to a project funded in this Action Plan.”
