THE CITY OF MINOT ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT (NO.1)

Through this Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery (DR) Amendment #1, the City will be deleting one of its original proposed projects identified in the approved Action Plan. The project is being removed due to time sensitive issues which will not allow the projects to move forward using CDBG disaster recovery funding. Attachment A provides a summary of the Action Plan changes which are in red. The following project is being removed:

- Infrastructure/3rd Street Sewer System-Sewer System Improvements. (\$905,000)

Monies from the above deleted projects will be allocated to the following existing project:

- Infrastructure/Master Lift Station-Rehabilitation of the Station which conveys 80% of the wastewater flow to the treatment center-(\$905,000)
